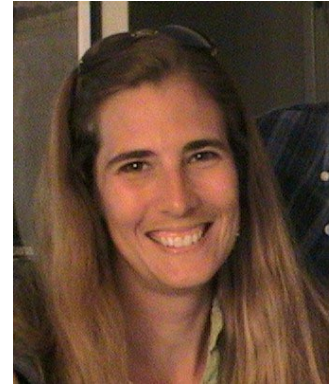

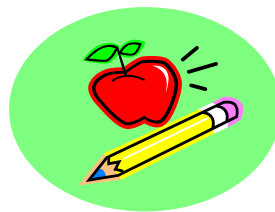


Primary Class Supply List for 2010-2011
