Early Elementary Supply List 2008-2009

Each family is asked to pay a materials fee of \$50 per child for the cost of Language, Math, Science, and Social Studies resource material to be used in the classroom. Installment payments (\$25 + \$25) can be made for your convenience.

- 1 computer jump drive (1 GB)
- 1 pencil box (very small)
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 highlighters (yellow)
- 2 packs of colored pencils
- 1 large box of Kleenex Tissue
- 5 Mead Composition Books
- 1 box 16 count crayon
- Plastic sheet protectors (50)
- 1 two inch, three ring binder with plastic view cover
- 1 pack of subject dividers (6-8 count)
- Four plastic pocket folders with prongs (red)
- Four plastic pocket folders with prongs (blue)
